NO MORE FITTING TRIBUTE TO THE WARSAW RESEARCHERS can be given than that by Dr. Milejkowski, written in October, 1942:

And you, Jewish physicians, you deserve some words of recognition.

What can I say to you, my companions in misfortune, my dear colleagues? You, too, were part of the whole. You, too, were menaced by forced labor, starvation, deportation, by all the forms of death that stalked our Ghetto. And you—you gave the murderers a bold answer with your work—"Non omnis moriar!"
